

Keep Saraland Beautiful Minutes for February 9, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Jason Weatherby. Lunch was brought and served by Mildred Blass. The food was blessed and we ate a lite lunch. There were 15 in attendance.

Kirsten Warren read the previous minutes taken on January 12th. Ron Mitchell made a motion to approve minutes and Jeanette Green seconded.

The treasurers report was given out with a recording balance of \$1,925.76. The storage building fee is a one-time fee of \$750, which was approved.

Janice Harvison noted that we do not have representation at the civic forum and that she would volunteer to be the rep for Saraland Civic Forum. Ron Mitchell made the motion to approve that we pay the \$25 to Saraland Civic Forum and Sarah Cornell seconded. The motion passed.

Carl Kelly and Sarah Cornell discussed Great American Cleanup. Shell will be purchasing plants for a beautification project rather than a cleanup project. Name of the cleanup group will not change. The tentative date is March 10th

Janice Harvison is going to double check with KAB on what the \$1,000 given to the affiliations of KAB can go toward. The money cannot be used for inventory-ice chests, only disposable ones. Carl Kelly asked if it could be used on plants/trees.

Fred Webb touched on the Gardening Workshop on March 11, 2017 from 10am-12pm. Mr. Miles will be the guest speaker. There will be no charge for the Gardening Workshop. Marketing the event by Chamber, city hall, and I Love Saraland Facebook page.

Earth Day, elementary School Project- April 10th was Earth Day and awards were given at the end of the year in May.

Webmaster-Fred Webb reported that the website was up to date and as soon as the Gardening Workshop flyer is made he will have Jackie Benson add it to the website.
