Adopt a Spot report was given by Ron. The newest spot at Jacintoport and Highway 43 is re-landscaped, it had to be cleaned out and new plants and palm trees added. We took over the island from Masland Carpet. An old ALDOT form from 2007 for right of way landscaping will be used going forward. ALDOT can't find any record of Saraland's old spots.

Juanita asks for money to upgrade landscaping around the Western welcome sign. She will draw a plan and submit it next month for discussion.

Barbara reported on Yard of the Month. 927 Cleveland Road was selected for October, the home of Doris Littleton. Barbara's husband will award next month's yard in her absence.

Fred reported on the Fall Garden Workshop and passed out flyers. Members signed up for door prizes and refreshments. The workshop is Saturday, October 26 at 10am.
